## Kirill BELOV

tenor



Kirill Belov (Tenor) was born in Ufa (Russia) in 1993. In 2018 he graduated from the Ufa State Institute of Arts (class of the Honored Artist of Russia, People's Artist of Bashkortostan Vladimir Belov).

As a fifth-year student, he was invited to the Mariinsky Academy of Young Opera Singers, where he was a soloist from 2017 to 2019. Made his debut at the Mariinsky Theater, in the role Kai in S. Banevich's opera "Kai and Gerda". Also, sang many concerts of the youth opera program of the Mariinsky Theater.

In 2019, he completed an internship at the Opera House of Monte-Carlo, where, as a result of the internship, he received a contract for the role of an "Innocent" in the opera "Boris Godunov" (M.Mussorgsky). From December 2019 to October 2020, he became soloist of the Youth Opera Program of the Bolshoi Theater of Russia, where he participated in many projects of the youth opera program of the Bolshoi Theater and took part in master classes of the stars of the opera stage. He has received master classes by Plácido Domingo, Ernesto Palacio, Elizabeth Vidal and Makvala Kasrashvili.

He took part in the second and fourth International Music Festival of Ildar Abdrazakov. From 2020 to 2021 he was a soloist of the Bashkir State Opera and Ballet Theater. His debut in this theater took place with the role of Foresto, at the opera "Attila" (G.Verdi). In April and May 2021, he performed the role of the Innocent, at the Opera House of Monte-Carlo in the opera Boris Godunov. In July 2021, he made his debut at the "Opera for All" festival in St. Petersburg, singing the role of Bogdan Sobinin in the opera "A Life for the Tsar" (M.I.Glinka).
